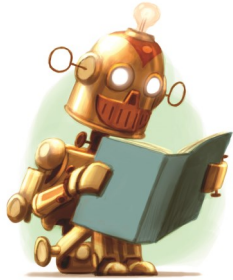

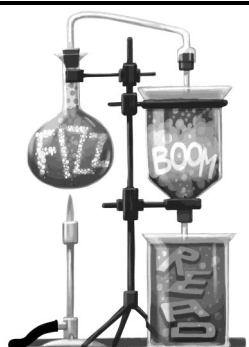
TUESDAY NIGHT MOVIE - Tuesday, May 20th at 6:00 pm in the ICN Room
